



## Extract the greatest value from low-cost grazing with molasses based liquid feeds

Grazed grass has high levels of rumen degradable protein (RDP) which must be balanced with rapidly fermentable energy in order to be utilised, the rapidly growing grasses also present issues with magnesium deficiency

An unbalanced ration can quickly lead to metabolic problems such as bloat, grass staggers and subacute ruminal acidosis (SARA), which can decrease feed intakes

The lack of fibre in fresh grass is a further challenge for efficient rumen function

Supplementation with straw and an ED&F Man molasses blend within a buffer feed will provide the structural fibre needed to maintain rumen function and reduce the risk of SARA

Liquid feeds also provide a source of readily fermentable energy to the rumen microbes creating a synergistic environment which aids in the utilisation of protein

With the supply of magnesium in fresh grass is low, add magnesium to your ED&F Man molasses based liquid feed in order to help limit deficiencies and prevent grass staggers
